Use your phone to deposit your check at any time and from anywhere.



Move Money

Link your other accounts to your Coloramo account and move money between them.



Coloramo will no longer offer shared branching services after January 28, 2023. However, members can still easily access cash, make a deposit, and move money from anywhere and at any time.

The Perfect Drink for a Cold Winter Day:

Make this Yummy homemade hot chocolate in just 5 minutes! Ingredients:

- 4 cups milk (preferably whole or 2%)
- ¼ cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- ¼ cup granulated sugar
- ½ cup semisweet chocolate chips or chopped chocolate bar
- ¼ teaspoon pure vanilla extract

Instructions:

Place milk, cocoa powder and sugar in a small saucepan. Heat over medium/medium-low heat, whisking frequently, until warm (but not boiling). Add chocolate chips and whisk constantly until the chocolate chips melt and distribute evenly into the milk. Whisk in vanilla extract, serve immediately. 02/12
