Please return this coupon to the credit union at least **ONE WEEK** before your payment due date. All persons obligated on the original loan must sign this coupon. Loans must be of current status. Only two Skip A Payments may be granted per calendar year. You must have made six timely payments before Skip A Pay will be approved. **Does not apply to credit cards or loans secured by real estate.**

I wish to skip my (check one) June July or August loan payment. I understand that there will be a **\$35.00 processing fee for each loan payment skipped.** My loan term (or maturity date on closed-end loans) will be extended and interest will continue to accrue during the month that my payment is skipped. My credit rating will not be negatively affected. GAP Insurance may not cover skipped payments. The missed payments may be deducted from the amount you will receive if you file a claim. Other restrictions may apply. Your normal monthly payments will resume the month after the payment is skipped.
